Tuesday, July 11 – 10:30 a.m. Farm tour, Mt. Kisco – noon – Lunch

Tour a wonderful local farm, and then sample their wares at a delicious lunch. Cabbage Hill Farm and Foundation is a non-profit organization located in Mount Kisco dedicated to the preservation of the small farm, historic farm animals, and the practice of sustainable agriculture and aquaponics. Part of their mission is to increase awareness through an educational model built around a working farm. In addition to several kinds of livestock, you will see a greenhouse used to produce high quality greens and fish year round using nitrogen rich water that fish are reared in to grow vegetables. The aquaponics system is a closed system that uses very little water and land to yield a high amount of protein and vegetables. Further, there are vegetables and greens in raised beds, fields, and hoop houses using organic compost without pesticides or genetically modified seeds.

After the tour, we will adjourn to 251 Lex in Mount Kisco for a delicious lunch featuring products from the Farm. The lunch will include Pita and Dips, Salad, Appetizers, a choice of entrée with family style sides and dessert, including beverages and a glass of house red or white wine. Price for lunch is \$40. You can sign up for the tour and lunch together or separately if you can only attend one portion.
